

HOUSE RULES

Cellular Telephones

Speaking on cellular phones and/or use of a headset, earbuds, or similar devices is prohibited in the interior portions of the Clubhouse and the exterior dining areas, including the Pavilion. All electronic devices must be on silent mode.

Dining Attire

The required attire for gentlemen is best described as "Club Casual" (i.e.: collared shirts, Tommy Bahama style shirts, slacks, nice Bermuda length dress shorts, and neat denim.) Tennis and yachting attire are permitted. Jackets are optional. Similar attire is requested for ladies and children. Nice flip flops are permitted.

Unacceptable Attire

Bare feet, sweat soaked clothes, wet bathing suits, sheer or fishnet cover-ups, tank tops, sleeveless shirts for gentlemen and sports bras and bare midriff/cropped tops for women, cut off shorts, or dirty flip flops are not acceptable attire. No ripped, torn, or tattered jeans allowed in the Clubhouse by men or women. Medical scrubs are not permitted on Club property.

Headwear

Gentleman may not wear hats, caps or visors inside the Clubhouse, except for religious or medical purposes. Ladies may wear dressy hats, but not sports caps.

Smoking

Cigarette and cigar smoking is prohibited in all dining areas. There is one designated smoking receptacle located on the North Handicap ramp of the Clubhouse. Cigar smoking is only permitted outside on the Northeast lawn at the point, unless specified for a sanctioned Club event. The Board of Governors extends the ban on cigarette smoking in the dining areas to include the use of electronic cigarettes or other vapor producing products.

Bathing Attire

Members and guests must wear Club appropriate bathing attire. Cheeky, thong-style bathing suits for ladies are not considered appropriate bathing attire and are not permitted. Appropriate bathing suit cover-ups (sheer or fishnet cover-ups are not permitted), shirts with sleeves for men and footwear must be worn while at the Pavilion Bar, seated under the Pavilion, or Pool Restrooms. No tank tops, sleeveless, or cut off shirts for gentlemen. Small children must wear swim diapers in the pool.

Tennis Attire

All players (including children and guests) must wear proper tennis attire. Smooth-soled, clay court, tennis shoes ONLY; no bare feet, cross trainers, flip flops, or hiking boots will be permitted. Proper shirt and shorts/skirt only; no sport bras, biking shorts, running shorts, or swimsuits will be permitted. Tank tops are not permitted for men.

Club Members and Guests over 12 years of age are expected to adhere to the Club's Dress Code. This applies to private events as well. Member and Guests shall dress in attire appropriate for each Club venue and in good taste on keeping the Club's long standing decorum.
