



# Castaway Kids' Camp 2026 FAQ

## **What to Wear and Pack**

Campers should dress in their shirts and comfortable shorts with their bathing suit under their clothing. Do not pack clothes with a midriff, offensive language/characters/symbols etc... Please pack a small backpack with the following items inside: sun protection (hat, sunglasses, spray sunscreen, rash guard, etc.) change of dry clothes each day, towel, a refillable water bottle, a bag to put wet clothing in and flip-flops or sandals for the pool. We recommend writing your child's name on everything, as things tend to get left behind when kids are having fun. Having a bag or backpack to hold everything in is a must!

## **Lunch and Snacks**

Kid-friendly snacks and lunch will be provided by the club daily for both full and half day campers. Each Monday we will order pizza from Papa Johns. If you would prefer to pack your own lunch or snacks for your child, please feel free to do so.

*\*If your child does not like or can not eat the lunch that is being provided, please pack a lunch from home.*

## **Medications**

LYC will not administer, dispense or store any medications other than epi-pens. Medications should be administered at home or special arrangements made to visit the child during the day.

## **Payments, Cancellations and Refunds**

For every CKC camper registered, there will be a one-time per summer \$50 non-refundable registration fee. \$20 surcharge for reservations made within 48hrs of the event. Additional Drop in rate of \$20 if you DO NOT sign up your child in advance. No show and no notification before the start of camp will result in a non-refundable full charge. We do understand that life happens, and plans change. If your child is unable to attend and cancellation occurs, we will gladly offer a credit towards a future day (of 2026 Summer Camp) as long as you have informed us and there is availability. If your child is sick, keep them at home, and you will be able to use your credit for another day of camp, as long as you have informed us and there is availability.

## **Do I need to be a Member to attend CKC Camp at LYC?**

Yes. However, if you are not a Member of LYC campers can register as a Member's Guest with a Member sponsoring them.

## **Will all ages be together or separate?**

As a general rule: ages 3-5 (Squids) will be together, ages 6-8 (Dolphins) will be together, and ages 9 – 12 (Sharks) will be together. All the children will be together for different activities throughout the day such as drop off, lunch time, etc. CKC Camp holds the right to vary or combine any of the age groups at any time it is deemed necessary due to the number of campers and/or activities being done. ### **What about supervision before and after class?**

CKC offers before care starting at 8:00 am – 9:00 am and after care from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm Monday - Friday for an additional charge of \$20 per any portion of an hour per child. Reservations for before and after care must be made in advance.

### **I lost my... Did you find it?**

We have a lost and found next to the front door of the CKC room where drop-off/pick-up is located. Please make sure to label everything very clearly with your child's name and phone number. Unclaimed items are donated after 30 days.

### **Will my child swim?**

All campers will need to take a swim test conducted by our LYC Lifeguards on their first day. We will have 4 levels of swimmers (see Camp Swim Assessment). Campers will be given their color band on the way to the pool. They must always keep the band on, or they will be treated as a non-swimmer for the remainder of that day.

## **Lunch and Snacks**

Kid-friendly snacks and lunch will be provided by the club daily. If you would prefer to pack your own lunch or snacks for your child, please feel free to do so. Please be courteous when choosing what food to bring from home and help us keep a peanut-free environment.

**Monday:** Pizza Day (LYC kitchen is closed)

Pizza (Papa Johns)

**Tuesday – Friday:** Kids will have a buffet including: Chicken Fingers, French Fries, Mac and Cheese, Caesar Salad, and Watermelon

**Tues:** Grilled Cheese

**Wed:** Hotdog/Corn Dog

**Thurs:** Burgers

**Fri:** Beef Tacos

**Beverages:** Lemonade, Water, and Gatorade (Gatorade is Summer Camp Only)

**Snacks:** Everyday kids will be given a choice from various chip options. We also do themed snacks throughout the week as an activity for the kids.

\*\* Please be courteous when choosing what food to bring from home and help us keep a PEANUT-FREE ENVIRONMENT.

\* Please note when numbers are lower we will order individual meals from the LYC kitchen Tuesday - Friday.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Member Guests must complete our secure, PCI-compliant authorization form to provide your payment details.

- \_\_\_\_\_ All allergies must be listed in **popsicle**.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Anybody who might pick up your camper must know the unique check-out code provided by the *MyCampApp* for LYC to be able to release your child.
- \_\_\_\_\_ If your child is in need of before (8-9 am) or aftercare (4-6 pm) for \$20/portion of an hour, please alert staff that your child will be checked in outside regular hours.
- \_\_\_\_\_ If you are running late for pick-up/drop-off, please alert LYC so staff may plan accordingly.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Please have your camper in their swimsuit and cover-up before camp arrival.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Please apply sunscreen to your camper before checking in to camp (we will reapply in the afternoon).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Swim bands will be issued daily, please do not bring home swim bands. If a swim band ends up going home with you, please return it to LYC.
